



















# Future Land Use Map

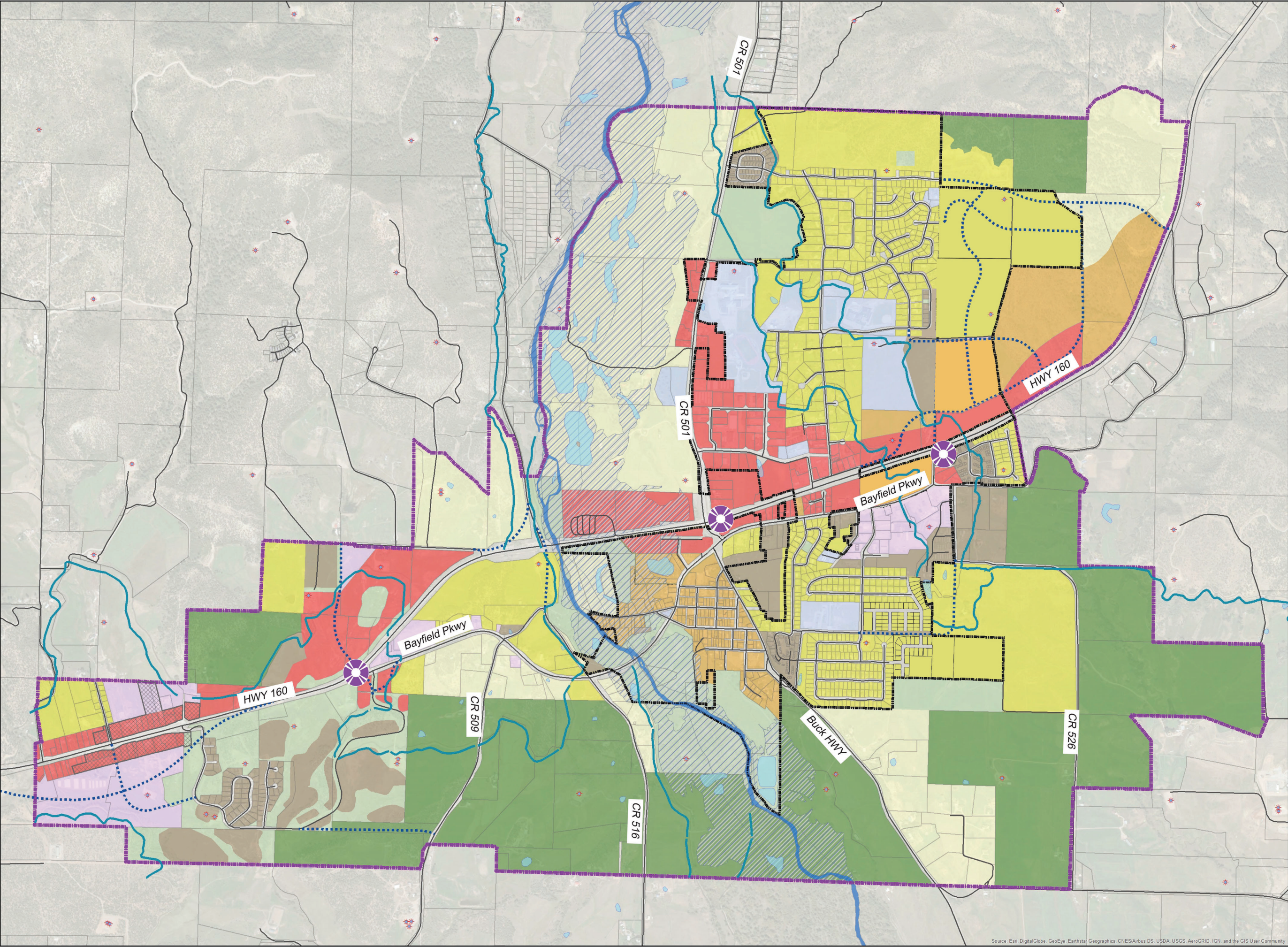
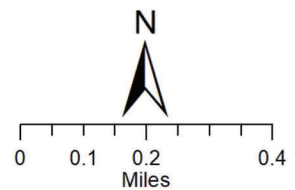
This map is a general representation of the future land use patterns and classifications.
