Resolution 506–Effective January 1, 2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BAYFIELD, COLORADO (HEREAFTER, THE "TOWN") FOR (1) BAYFIELD WATERWORK OPERATIONS (2) BAYFIELD SEWER ENTERPRISE (3) VOLUNTARY FEES ASSESSED TO COVER THE COST OF MOSQUITO CONTROL AND (4) POWERS OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGARDING SOLID WASTE, AMENDING RATES AND CHARGES FOR WATER, SEWER, MOSQUITO CONTROL AND SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE TOWN HEREIN REFERRED TO AS UTILITY RATES AND FEES

Sewer Residential

- ♦ Base \$81.30
- ♦ 38¢ per kgal for 0-6,000
- ♦ \$1.13 per kgal 6,000-15,000 winter

Residential customers will be charged for 6,000 gallons of sewer usage unless they can prove a lower (Winter) November through March water usage via a water purveyor billing.

<u>Utility Relief</u> LEAP, Low-income Energy Assistance Program, is designed to assist lowincome households with paying their winter home heating costs, but is not intended to pay the entire cost. You do not need to live in town to apply or benefit from this personal assistance, however, if you are a town utility customer you may be eligible for additional assistance from the Town Utility Relief Fund for water, sewer and garbage.
