








Mustang Crossing—East of Mesa Meadows

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION BRIEFS

Marlin Village (2-acres): Annexed just west of the twin bridges on Bayfield Parkway and with an application for a 15 Space Tiny Home Village.

Mustang Crossing (35-acres): Approved for annexation just east of Mesa Meadows with a 85 lot medium density residential subdivision sketch plan in the review and public hearing process in February.

Clover and Orchard (1-acre): Planned Unit Development (PUD) 14 lot townhome single family residential development.

2107 Bayfield Parkway (17-acres): Approved for annexation just west of the Conoco/Alta location. Commercial development is proposed.

Bayfield East Annexation (162-acres): Applied for annexation east of the town boundary and north of US 160. A mixed commercial, high density and low density residential development considered for Planned Unit Development (PUD) over several years.
