The Board of Trustees and the Planning Commission will hold a Joint Work Session on

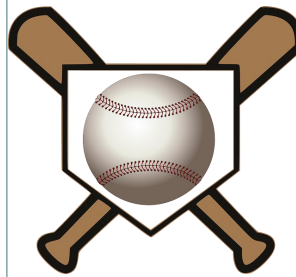
