Town implements Fats, Oils, and Grease Program

In 2023, Bayfield Public Works is implementing a program to control the amount of fats, oils and grease (FOG) introduced into the Town's sewer collection and treatment facilities.

Excessive amounts of FOG can have negative effects on the operation of the wastewater treatment plant, cause hard-to-remove blockages in the collection system, and gum up lift stations.

Public Works is asking residents to not pour used cooking oil, bacon grease, or similar down the drain, but rather collect in an empty jar or tub and discard with garbage. Restaurants and businesses are required to have a grease trap or interceptor installed and serviced regularly.

Town of Bayfield systems are currently FOG neutral and this program will ensure we do not develop any problems in the future.
