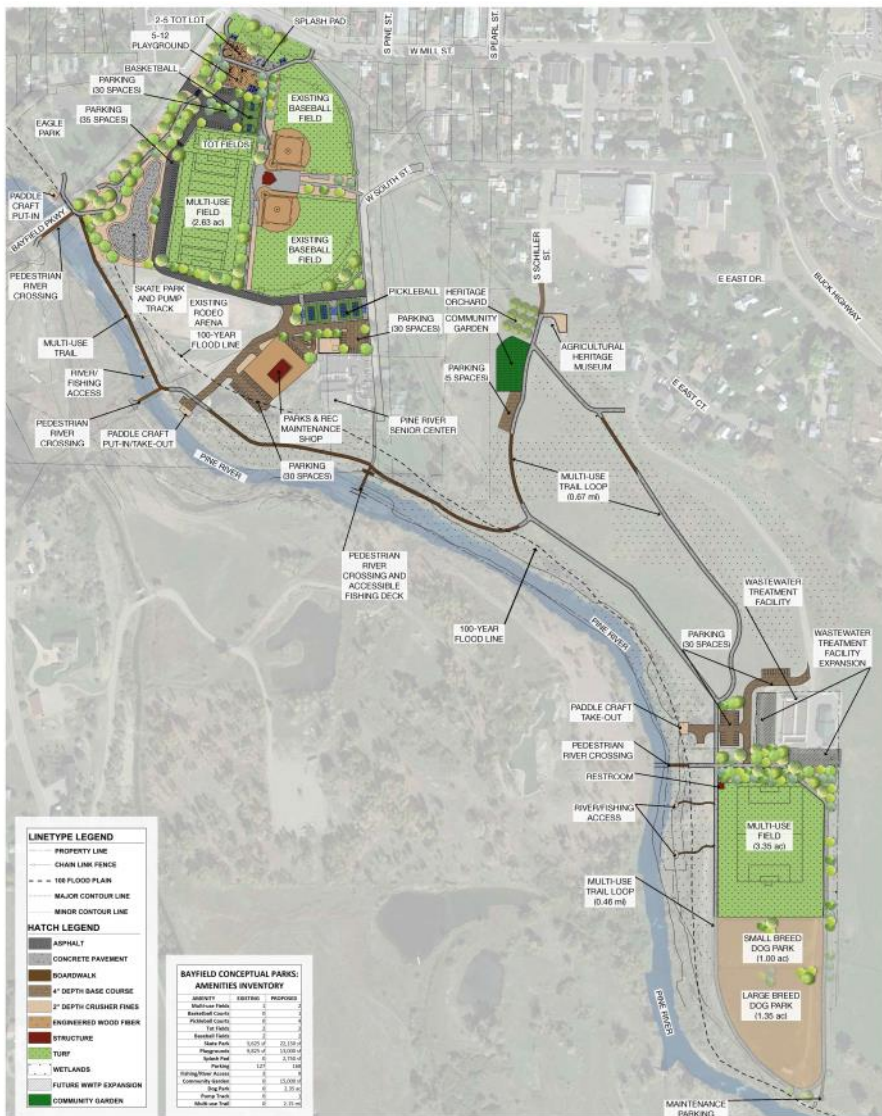
Park Master Plan

On Tuesday, August 15, 2023, the Board of Trustees approved the Final Conceptual Park Design based on community input. Town staff will continue to work with the park consultants to add phasing to the park plan and get preliminary cost estimates. In order to pay for the park and other parks and recreation services, the Board of Trustees is considering a sales tax proposal for the November 7, 2023 ballot that would go towards the following:

- ♥ Master Park Plan Development
- ♥ Park & Trail Operations
- ♥ Senior Center Operations
- ♥ Youth and Adult Sports/Rec
- ♥ Cultural & Community Events
- ♥ Pine River Arena

A dedicated sales tax for park development will improve the Town's chances for grant funding. For more information, visit:
