AVOID PAYING A SNOW REMOVAL FEE!

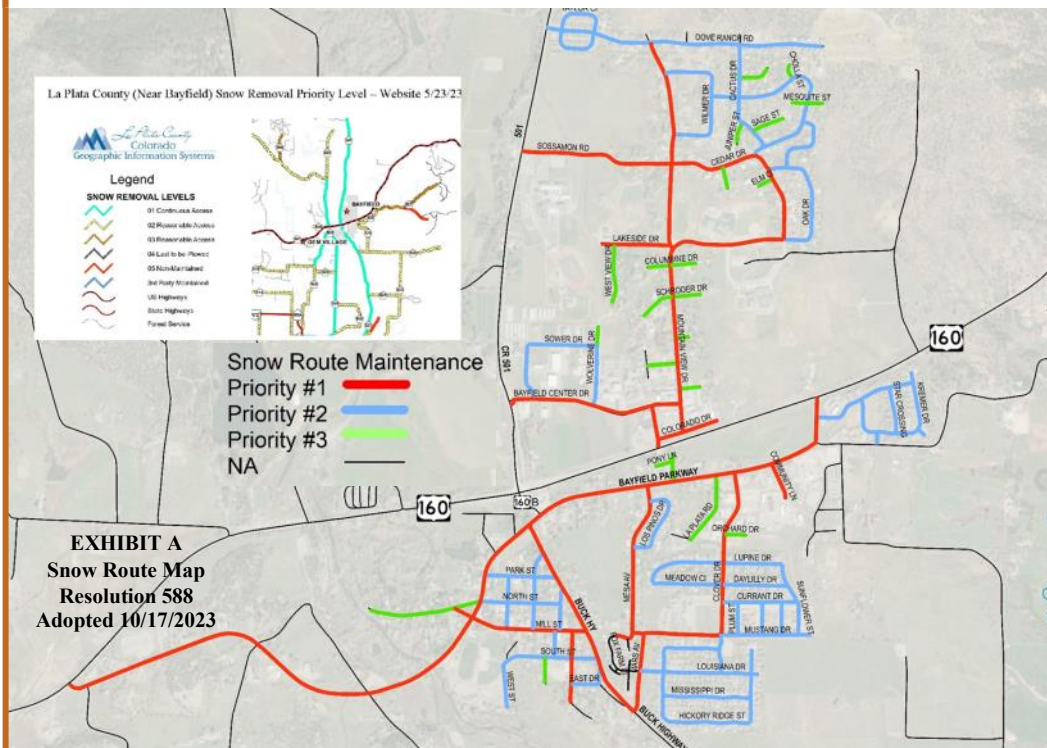
When you shovel snow it must be stored on your property. If your property is restricted in snow storage space please contact Town Hall and Public Works Director Schulz may arrange an alternative.
