Senior Center is offering another vaccine clinic on Tuesday, April 2nd from 9am-11:30am through Rivergate Pharmacy. Vaccines offered are flu, shingles (dose 1 or 2), pneumonia, RSV, and COVID. Insurance information can be run on the day of the clinic or you can call Rivergate Pharmacy at 970-375-7711 ahead of time to run a test claim.
