



## IMPORTANT PARADE INFORMATION

**PARADE CHECK-IN/STAGING:** The parade will begin at 10:30am. Check-in opens at 8am and **all entries must be checked in by 10am to be able to participate in the parade.** We encourage everyone to arrive as early as possible. Check-in location is on W. South St. behind the softball fields. The only access point into the staging area and check-in station is from E. East Dr and the Buck Hwy. Please note: South St becomes very crowded so please check in early to avoid traffic jams.

**PARADE PERMITS:** All parade entry vehicles must have a permit to access the staging entrance on E. East Dr. All vehicles without a permit will be denied access. The parade staging area is only for parade entries and vehicles in the parade. All other vehicles must find parking outside the staging area with an exemption to horse trailers. Permits must be obtained from Bayfield Parks & Recreation by June 30<sup>th</sup>. Please fill in the information on your access permits prior to arrival to help keep traffic moving at the access permit checkpoint.

**PARADE LINE-UP & ROUTE:** The parade line-up will begin at S. West St. and continue down South St. The parade route will be down Mill St.

### PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS:

- YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO “THROW” CANDY OR ANYTHING ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE! This is for the safety of the spectators and to prevent children from running out into the street. This will be strictly enforced.
- All entries must be in “good taste” and suitable for a family event.
- Parade entries are not allowed to exceed 15 feet in height.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Children on bikes, horses, ATVs, or skateboards must wear helmets.
- All entrants are to maintain “forward motion” throughout the parade route.
- Consumption of alcohol is prohibited during the parade route.
- Entries and participants must stay on marked route.
- No refunds
