

RESOLUTION 610

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BAYFIELD, COLORADO ADOPTING EMPLOYEE SAFETY POLICIES BY REFERENCE

WHEREAS, an Employee Handbook was adopted January 16, 2024; and

WHEREAS, an assortment of Employee Policies were adopted via Resolution 609; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees have determined that employee safety is considered a high priority; and

WHEREAS, supervisors shall inform and train applicable employees assigned to certain positions; and

WHEREAS, all eligible staff members have a level of oversight to protect employee safety and may be evaluated per one or more Employee Safety Policies; and

WHEREAS, the Employee Safety Policy list may be expanded as approved by the Town Leadership Team as directed by the Safety Coordinator or compiled as a Safety Manual and will be accepted without re-promulgation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BAYFIELD, COUNTY OF LA PLATA COUNTY, STATE OF COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

- Employee Safety Policy-10: Procedure for Workplace Accident Investigation
