IMPORTANT VENDOR INFORMATION

- All vendors will be setup in Joe Stephenson Park in designated spaces.
- No direct water or electricity will be provided.
- Generators are allowed.
- There is access to potable water at the building in Joe Stephenson Park.
- The parade starts at 10:30 am and vending can begin at any time.
- A commercial ice trailer will be on-site at \$2.00 per bag.

VENDOR CHECK-IN AND SET-UP: All vendors must check-in between 8 am and 10 am. Early arrival is allowed but must be approved by Bayfield Parks and Recreation. At check-in vendor will be directed to their designated spot in the park. There will be no vehicle access after 10 am. Check-in is located on S. West St. behind the softball fields. Access to this area is via E East Drive off the Buck Highway (CR 521). A vendor access permit must be hanging from the rear view mirror to pass through the area. Each vendor may receive two access permits.

VENDOR PERMITS: All vendor vehicles must have a permit to access the staging entrance on E. East Dr. All vehicles without a permit will be denied access. The staging area is only for vendor and parade entries, all other vehicles must find parking outside the staging area. Permits must be obtained from Bayfield Parks & Recreation by June 30th at 12pm. Please fill in the information on your access permits prior to arrival to help keep traffic moving at the access permit checkpoint.
